**NATIONAL CHARITY LEAGUE, INC. FORMS FIRST CHAPTER IN SOUTH CAROLINA**

**Greenville, SC -- December 14, 2020** – [National Charity League, Inc.](#) (NCL), the nation's premier mother-daughter non-profit organization, announced the formation of the Greenville Chapter. This is the organization's 283<sup>rd</sup> chapter to form in the United States.

The Greenville Chapter is open to mothers and daughters who reside in the Greenville area. This chapter is the first in South Carolina. NCL is also collecting interest in starting new chapters for mothers and daughters in the city of Columbia and the Charleston/Mount Pleasant area.

In addition to participating in national philanthropic initiatives, the chapter's inaugural members will have the opportunity to choose which local organizations they will support through hands-on volunteer service hours. Daughters in 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, known as Ticktockers, and their mothers, known as Patronesses, will together embark on a core program focused on philanthropy, strengthening mother-daughter relationships, cultural experiences, and leadership opportunities.

Chapter President, Jannie Darwin said, "We are so excited to be the first NCL chapter in South Carolina. This gives us a great opportunity to work with our daughters, and I look forward to seeing the impact it will have on our Greenville community."
