Dallas, Texas (September 7, 2021) – [National Charity League, Inc.](https://www.nclonline.org) (NCL), the nation's premier mother-daughter non-profit organization, announced the formation of the White Rock Lake Chapter. With the addition of the White Rock Lake Chapter, NCL now has 287 chapters across the country.
