**NATIONAL CHARITY LEAGUE, INC. OPENS 2020 WITH TWO NEW
CHAPTER FORMATIONS IN TEXAS**

DALLAS/SAN ANTONIO, TX (February 3, 2020) – [National Charity League, Inc.](http://NationalCharityLeague.com) (NCL), the nation's premier mother-daughter non-profit organization, announced the formation of two new Texas chapters - the Trophy Club Chapter near Dallas, and the New Braunfels Chapter near San Antonio. These are the 273rd and 274th Chapters to form in the nation.

The Trophy Club Chapter is open to mothers and daughters who reside or attend school in the Northwest ISD. Last year, the existing 38 chapters in the Dallas/Fort Worth area served over 208,000 philanthropy hours to local partners. In addition to participating in national philanthropic initiatives, the chapter's inaugural members will have the opportunity to choose which local organizations they will support through hands-on volunteer service hours. Daughters in 7th through 12th grade, known as Ticktockers, and their mothers, known as Patronesses, will together embark on a core program focused on philanthropy, strengthening mother-daughter relationships, cultural experiences and leadership opportunities.

The New Braunfels Chapter is open to mothers and daughters who reside in the New Braunfels area. This is the 6th chapter to form in the greater San Antonio area. The New Braunfels Chapter will serve local philanthropies such as Comal County Senior Citizens Foundation, New Braunfels Food Bank, Believing for Bryleigh, and McKenna Children's Museum.

"Texas is fortunate to have these amazing new chapters of women in their state," said Renée Tuzee, CEO, National Charity League, Inc. "Like the existing chapters in Texas that paved the way for future growth, I am confident that these groups will go above and beyond to spread the philanthropic message of National Charity League's initiatives to their communities."
